

21. Syllabic Consonants

Objective: This lesson explains to learners that the concept of 'syllabic', or syllabic segments is not constrained to vowels alone, but certain number of consonants can stand as peaks.

Syllabic Consonants refer to those segments where no vowel is found, and where the consonant itself stands a peak. The nasals and laterals, and the retroflex r can be syllabics.
