How to say « 0 » ?

There are several ways to pronounce the number « 0 » , usage varies between different English-speaking countries .

Types of numbers :

<u>*Cardinal numbers :</u> are the numbers that represent quantity . eg : one ,two , three , four.... (used mainly for counting).

Cardinal numbers are normally used when you :

_count things : eg : Ihave two brothers/ there are thirty one days in January.

_give your age : eg : lam thity three years old/ my sister is twenty seven years old .

_give your telephone number : eg : our phone number is two , six , three, eight.....

_ give years : eg : she was born in nineteen seventy five.

<u>*Ordinal numbers</u>: are the numbers that represent order in series .eg: first, second, third......(used mainly for putting things in a sequance), you can normally create ordinal numbers by adding « th »to the end of a cardinal numbers.

Ordinal numbers are normally used when you :

_ give a date : eg : my birth day is on the 27th of January.

- _ put things in a sequance : eg :
- _ give the floor of building : eg : his office is on the tenth floor.

_ have a birth day : eg : he had a huge party for his twenty first birth day.

<u>*Even numbers :</u> are the numbers can be divided by two/ are the numbers can be divided into groups of two. **Eg :** [2,4,6,8]

<u>*Odd numbers :</u> are the numbers can not be divided by two/ are the numbers can not be divided into groups of two. **Eg :** [1, 3, 5, 7, 9.....]
