Pronunciation rules for final -ed-and-s-

1. Final's'

If a word ends in the letter's' (e.g. plural noun or verb in the third person), there are three ways to pronounce this's' - /S/, /Z/ and /IZ/.

/S/	If the word ends in one of the following sounds:

2. Final 'ed'

If a word ends in the letter 'ed'(e.g. adjective or the past of a regular verb) may be pronounced/T/, /D/ or /ID/.
