Adverb clause :

1- **Purpose:** so that, in order that, in order to

- He went early
- He wanted to attend both conferences
- He went early **so that** he could attend both conferences

2- **Place:** where, wherever, anywhere

- I will follow you
- You go home or anywhere
- I will follow you **wherever** you go

3- **Manner:** as / like

- Here is the work achieved
- You want the work achieved this way
- Here is the work achieved **as** you want

4- **Cause:** because, for, since, as

- He never misses English sessions
- He is fun of English
- He never misses English sessions **because** he is fun of it.

5- **Consequence:** therefor, as a result, so, as a sequence, consequently, thus

- He always practices in English
- He has improved his English pronunciation
- He always practices in English **therefor** he has improved his pronunciation.

6- **Concession:** although, though, even though, yet, nevertheless

- He missed the train
- He did his best to be on time in the station
- He missed the train **although** he did his best to be on time in the station.
